Subject: LDI Bulletin 2021-04; Insurance Data Security Law

On June 10, the Louisiana Department of Insurance (“LDI”) revised and reissued its Bulletin 2021-04 (originally issued June 3), regarding the implementation of the Insurance Data Security Law, Act 283 (HB 614) of the 2020 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature. See prior WFG Bulletin [LA 2020-12](#).

Licensees with fewer than 25 employees, less than \$5 million in gross annual revenue, or less than \$10 million in year-end total assets are exempt from the information security program requirements of La. R.S. 22:2504. There is no exemption from the cybersecurity breach investigation or notification requirements of La. R.S. 22:2505 and 2506.

Licensed producers or agents do not need to submit annual certification or exemption forms to the LDI.
