Maryland title insurance producers, other than licensed Maryland attorneys, are required to complete 16 total hours of continuing education ("CE") classes every two years, of which 3 hours must be for ethics credits.

Under revised statute MD Insurance § 10-116(a)(2) that goes into effect on January 1, 2020, CEs must be completed no later than 15 days before the expiration date of the insurance producer's license.
