Subject: County Clerks/Registers Closures due to Coronavirus Update as of 3-17-2020

The New Jersey Land Title Association (NJLTA) is monitoring the status of all County Clerks/Registers Offices in response to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. Below is the latest information as reported by the NJLTA as of 3-17-2020:

1. [Bergen County Clerk](#): The Clerk's office is open. The Clerk's satellite offices scheduled for Saddle River (March 18) and River Vale (March 24, 25 & 26) and River Vale – MVC Mobile Unit (March 25) have been cancelled and will be rescheduled at a later date.
2. [Burlington County Clerk](#): The Clerk's office is closed to the public; however, employees will report to work and be available by phone and email. Any questions, please call 609-265-5142 or email [countyclerk@co.burlington.nj.us](mailto:countyclerk@co.burlington.nj.us) if you need assistance.
3. [Camden County Clerk](#): The Clerk's office is closed to the public until April 1, 2020.
4. [Essex County Clerk](#): The Clerk is reducing the hours of title searches from 8:30 am to 1:00 pm, Monday through Friday.
5. [Hudson County Register](#): The Register is encouraging filers to use an e-filing service.
6. [Mercer County Clerk](#): The Clerk's office is closed to the public.
7. [Middlesex County Clerk](#): The Clerk's office is closed to the public. No walk-in recordings, only E-file and mail will be accepted. A skeleton crew will be present.
8. [Monmouth County Clerk](#): The Clerk's office is closed to the public, however, employees will report to work and will continue to accept recordable instruments via mail and e-Recording. For hand deliveries of recordable instruments, a drop off basket is located in the lobby of the building at 33 Mechanic Street, Freehold Borough.
9. [Morris County Clerk](#): The Clerk's office is closed to the public. Title searchers, however (only those who are there every day) will be able to continue to use the records room, for now.
