Subject: Update on the Somerset County Cybersecurity Breach

The New Jersey Land Title Association (NJLTA) has issued a memorandum updating the cyber-attack situation in Somerset County, which was reported in our previous [Informational Bulletin No. NJ 2022-02](#).

According to the memo, it appears the county search website is operating and they have resumed e-recordings as of June 6, 2022. It advises that the county has kept all documents received in chronological order since the shutdown and are working on them in the order in which they were received. As you can also see from the memo, as of June 8, 2022, the County has started working on the documents received via carrier or walk-ins also in the order in which they were received.
