Subject: New GIT/REP forms effective 10-1-2025

The NJ Division of Taxation has updated some of the GIT/REP forms and the RTF-1EE Form. The Division of Taxation advises that prior versions of the forms will not be accepted after October 1, 2025.

Please note that deeds submitted for recording using the old forms will likely be rejected.

The New Jersey Land Title Association (NJLTA) sent an email notification to its members and included the updated forms below.

- 1. GIT/REP-3 (Seller's Residency Certification/Exemption)
- 2. RTF-1EE (8.25) Affidavit of Consideration for Graduated Percent Fee
- 3. GITREP-4 (8.25) Waiver of Seller's Filing Requirement
- 4. GITREP-4A (8.25) Waiver of Seller's Filing Requirement for Corrected Deed
