Subject: Cybersecurity Regulations – Compliance Certification

The deadline for filing the Certification of Compliance with the Cybersecurity Regulations is April 15, 2025. All covered entities and licensed persons, who are not "fully exempt" from the Cybersecurity Regulation, are required to submit the Certification attesting to their compliance for the 2024 calendar year. Please note that while many title insurance agents have an exemption, they may not be fully exempt and therefore are required to file the annual certification.
