Subject: Fraud Warning on Commitments

Agents are advised that the Ohio Revised Code requires the following insurance fraud warning:

"Any person who, with intent to defraud or knowing that he is facilitating a fraud against an insurer, submits an application or files a claim containing a false or deceptive statement is guilty of insurance fraud." [Ohio Revised Code §3999.21]

This language should be placed at either the top or bottom of Schedule A of the title commitment. A copy of the commitment should be provided to all proposed insureds in advance of closing.
