Previously, in WFG Underwriting <u>Bulletin No. PA 2019-01</u>, we advised that the Philadelphia Office of Judicial Records (formerly known as the Prothonotary) online systems were down and as a result, Common Pleas and Municipal Court cases and judgments are unable to be searched. In an effort to keep you informed of the situation in Philadelphia, we will send updates as we receive them.

Here's the latest as of today, June 12, 2019:

An Update from The Pennsylvania Land Title Association (PLTA)

The websites of the First Judicial District ("FJD") remain unavailable. However, while the
problem is being rectified, the FJD has set up six terminals to provide access to the
Judgment Index and Dockets for the Court of Common Pleas and the Municipal Court as
well as the Locality Index. Filings cannot be accessed at these terminals at this time and
members should consult their searchers concerning the cover date as the records
available do not reflect more recent filings. Three terminals are located at each of the
following locations:

• The Widener Building, 1339 Chestnut Street, 10th Floor, Room 1020 The Criminal Justice Center, 1301 Filbert Street, Room 205

Additionally, the FJD is working to docket those matters filed during the outage. The docketing date will reflect the date the documents were left for filing with the FJD.

We will continue to provide updates as new information becomes available.
