The Pennsylvania Land Title Association ("PLTA") has notified its members that increases will apply to documents submitted for recording in Philadelphia on or after July 1, 2025:

- The Transfer Tax will increase to a total of 4.578% (3.578% to the City of Philadelphia and 1% to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania).
- Recording fees for documents affected by the Housing Trust Fund fee will increase by \$3. The fees are now as follows:
  - Deeds: \$277.75
  - Miscellaneous Deeds: \$262.75
  - Mortgages: \$247.75
  - Assignments of Mortgage: \$245.75
  - Releases of Mortgage: \$230.75
  - Mortgage Satisfactions: \$230.75
