First, under the SEARCH OF TITLE section, you are asked if WFG provided title evidence for this file. If so, put an "X" in the box and go directly to the next section of the form (PROPERTY LOCATION AND TYPE). If WFG did not provide your title evidence, leave that box empty and on the next line indicate whether title evidence came from your own company ("in-house") or from some other company. After checking one of those boxes please complete the rest of the SEARCH OF TITLE section.
